



Mobilizing Partnerships to Advance a Provincial Intersectoral Network on Trans-affirming Practice to Support Sexual Assault Survivors

Complete the PARTNER Survey! *DEADLINE EXTENDED*

A few weeks ago, we launched a social network analysis of the trans-LINK Network using an accessible online tool called **PARTNER**.

So far, just over 40% of trans-LINK member organizations have responded. The participation of ALL Network members is key in identifying how we can better collaborate to serve our communities. As such, we have **extended** the deadline to complete the PARTNER Survey to **July 14, 2021**.

As a reminder, the PARTNER Survey should only take **10 minutes to complete**.

Using PARTNER data, we will create a 2-page summary highlighting findings about your organization and the impact of COVID-19 on collaboration.

Additionally, **EVERYONE** who completes the survey will be entered into a draw for one of two **electronic gift cards, each worth \$250**.

Both the summaries and the gift cards will be issued once all responses have been collected and the data have been analyzed.



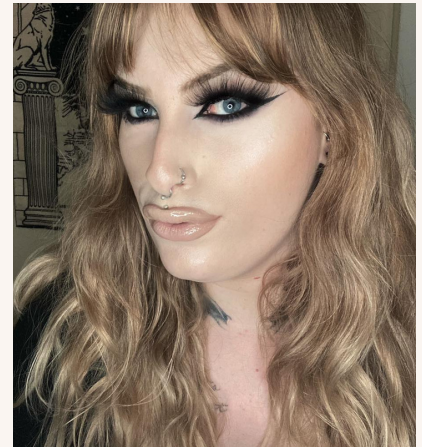
Peer Leader Spotlight - Angelina Grace
